

NEW VENUE for 2012!

Whitemoor Lakes Conference and Activity Centre

This exciting new adventure centre is part of Action Centres UK. It opens in October 2011 and in addition to a full range of activity facilities (mainly for youth groups) it has two large self-contained conference suites.

This offers us many advantages as our conference venue:

- full board - all meals are provided, buffet-style in the large dining hall (except the Conference Supper on the Saturday evening)
- breakout rooms for short sessions
- opportunity to run an extra session on the Friday evening – to get the conference off to an early start!
- all facilities are on the ground floor throughout

The purpose-built accommodation “lodges” are connected to a central conference suite and are self-contained for each group using the Centre. Each lodge has:

- family rooms for 2, 3 or 4 people to share, each comprising twin beds and a set of bunks
- single occupancy is quoted separately below
- en-suite facilities in each room
- bed linen provided, you only need to bring towels
- specially adapted disabled rooms - two per lodge
- large communal lounges with adjacent kitchen facilities
- tea and coffee machines available 24-hour for each lodge

NB - Whitemoor Lakes operates a strict NO ALCOHOL policy

Delegate Fee Options

Option 1a

Full board (Family room) – from Friday supper to Sunday lunch all inclusive
£200 per delegate (for two or more sharing)

Option 1b

Single occupancy supplement
£260 per delegate

Option 2

Non residential
£120 per delegate for 2 days, including lunches on both days

NB – as usual the Saturday Conference Supper will be charged separately – in the region of £25 per head – this will be held at the NMA, details will be circulated nearer the time
